Thoroughly enjoyed my day judging some of the beautiful boys, young and senior.

Very happy on the whole with mouths feet and movement, there were some gorgeous heads and expressions which made my job very enjoyable. Eye shape and colour all very pleasing. MPD (2) 1 Turners Dazycutting Blazing Fire. Six and a half month old pup. A promising young boy, took everything in his stride, producing extremely good movement for a youngster, correct scissor bite, well balanced head, lovely eye, good neck leading into well placed shoulders. Nice lay back upper arm, good bone and feet, deep through body, good bend of stifle and beautiful straight hocks which he drove off like a pro. Slashing his tail he made a lovely picture. Strongly considered for Best Puppy lost out on maturity. 2 Pullen & Atkins Covarney Can't Hear You At Jacingail. 8 month old boy. A very attractive young lad, pleasing head and expression, good colour eye, ear placement fine. Good length of neck leading to well-placed shoulders. Sternum and upper arm good, deep through body, good bone, correct stifle angulation, lost out on movement unfortunately. I am sure when he has come to settle and has more control he will be a very promising youngster. PD (2,1a) 1 Poole's Gwendariff Ring Aring Aroses IKC. Nine months old. Gorgeous big strong puppy, correct scissor bite, beautiful head and expression, gorgeous dark brown eyes of correct shape, good ear placement, length of neck fine leading to well placed clean shoulders, upper arm and sternum very good, deep through body, adequate bone, neat feet, very good hind angulation allowing him to drive and move beautifully around the ring well slashing his tail. VD (4) 1 Murchinson's Kerryfair Please Please Me Corphin ShCEX 8 years old. Very nice class of senior boys that have all excelled in the ring. This boy stood out due to correct outline and substance, beautifully balanced standing and moving, gorgeous head and expression hardly showing any grey to his lovely foreface, neck, sternum, shoulders and upper arm all correct, deep through body, stifle and quarters strong allowing for his strong movement covering the ground easily. I was so pleased to award him Veteran Dog in Breed. 2 Russells Shch Lynwood Hocus Pocus As Settesoli JW 9 years old. This mature boy very similar to my 1st in class. Again, very pleasing head and expression, good bone, strong angulation in good coat. Moved well, just lost out to my class winner as movement was not as positive and drive not so purposeful. 3 Davison's Shch Bardonhill You Don't Fool Me. JD (5,1a) 1 Neil & Ellrichs Gwendariff The Nude Dude (IKC). 13 months old. A young lad, his name suits him, a real dude! Everything about this boy is fantastic, correct head expression, good reach of neck leading to very good shoulders, correct upper arm length, fore chest well developed, beautifully deep through body,

strong over croup tail set correct, stifle, hocks, quarters all fine very well put together. Tight feet, moved beautifully, correct sloping top line, this handsome DUDE will go far I feel. 2 Hyslop's Gwendrarriff Little White Lie (IKC). 13 months old. I see looking at catalogue for date and birth that this boy brother of my winner is very similar in type. Their coats slightly different and this boy slightly smaller, having said that he has all the same attributes of his brother, two handsome young dogs, this boys' movement not quite so positive as one, however I am sure he has a very bright future. 3 Foster Ixia Boys Don't Cry At Shanoah. YD (4,1a) 1 Harris Fairhaven Young Soul For Konakakela (IMP.SWE) JW 22 months old. This young lad has grown into a very attractive Setter, pleasant head and expression, ample reach of neck leading to good shoulders and lay back of upper arm, good bone and well arched feet, deep through body, strong sloping top line beautiful quarters, short hocks which allowed him to drive off around the ring showing him to be a very happy boy, in good coat and condition. 2 Richardson's Bluesprings Linda's Legacy At Forestfire. 19 months old. This young lad very pleasing type, smaller dog than my winner, nicely balanced, attractive head and expression, good reach of neck, shoulders and sternum good correct upper arm return, plenty of bone, neat feet, deep and strong outline which had gentle slope, good width of thigh and bend of stifle, straight hocks, correct tail set, he also moved with drive very pleasing to watch. 3 Cararua Pearl Of Fortune. ND (4,2a,1w/d) 1st no:89 who was placed 2nd in Yearling. UGD (3) 1st was no:43. My winner from yearling. 2 Gilbert's Kerrimere Night Breeze Among Joanmas. 2year old. This boy had gorgeous soft expression, low ear set, ample reach of neck, good shoulders and upper arm return, good bone correct feet in good coat, bend of stifle and strong quarters correct tail set, standing presented a balanced picture, moved with drive. 3 Broad's Thendara Traitor Among Ermebrook. 22 months old. Learnt from owner at later date that this boy, who had a lot to offer, had been unwell losing a lot of body and condition. I feel sure that when this improves with the great care that the owners are giving, he will have a good future in the ring. GD (6,1a) 1 Sheldon's Bardonhill That's Alright At Delsanto. 32 months old. This boy, so well balanced, beautiful head, good ear set melting expression, nice arch behind skull and good neck fitting into lovely shoulders, return of upper arm and sternum, good depth of body, adequate bone, lovely feet, strong straight hocks, very good stifle, correct sloping topline with a slight rise over the loin, powerful quarters correct tail set presented a pleasing picture and no surprise that he moved very well as in very good condition. 2 Bott & Alen & Morgan. Quensha The One Man Show (AI). 31 months. Well balanced boy true to type, scored in shoulders lay back upper arm, sternum also very strong quarters, which gave him the edge on the day as very happy showy movement, thus took my eye. 3 Holeham-Green's Loganrish Tiger Warrior JW. PGD (4) 1 Lorrimer Gwendarriff Disco Dazzler. 2 years and 6 months old. This boy was typical IRISH all the way through. Balanced outline and head, low set ears, good length of neck fitting nicely into laid back shoulders good sternum and return of upper arm lovely depth, adequate bone, neat feet, rear quarters did not disappoint, lovely short hocks and strong bend of stifle

correct sloping topline and tail set completed the picture as did his sound flowing movement. 2 Davison's Bardonhill Million Reasons. 4 years old. Again a very well-balanced dog, very pleasing head and expression low ear set, ample length of neck, laid back shoulders and return of upper arm well ribbed, gentle sloping top line strong quarters and short hocks which all helped give him lovely long strong driving movement. 3 Russell's Tiroen Touch Of Magic By Settesoli (Imp KCJ) JW. Mid L (7,1w/d) 1 Dewars Gwendariff Bobby Dazzler. A lovely eye-catching young boy at two years and ten months has grown into a beautifully balanced dog, very eye catching when standing, gorgeous head and expression, correct eye shape with good colour, correct ear placement with good length. Lovely Reach of neck leading into good shoulder placement, very good length and return of upper arm, fore-chest well developed, beautifully deep through body, ample bone and neat feet, gently sloping top line form with correct tail set, bend of stifle and well-muscled quarters and second thigh, which enabled him to drive off moving beautifully around the ring. 2 Cohen's Lynwood Merry May King With Shushana. A smaller dog than 1st but very nice type, well balanced all through, plenty of work in the head, good ear placement, ample reach of neck which flowed into well laid shoulders, good sternum, ample bone good feet, stronger hind quarters well bent stifle and short hocks, moved with drive. 3 Sheldons Bardonhill That's All Right At Delsanto. Sadly in this class two lovely boys both suffering cold tail. L (9,1w/d) 1 Botts Badonhill Million To One. What a super boy have admired him over the last 3 years but a real privilege to be able to go over him, such beautiful balance standing, gorgeous head and expression, correct eye shape and colour, correct ear set and length arch at the back of head, showing off ample reach of neck which moulded in to correct shoulder placement lovely front angulation lay back of upper arm very nice sternum ample, good depth through body strong quarters bend of stifle and hocks straight to ground correct tail set which he used well on the move, sloping but firm topline finished the picture, was very pleased to award him RDCC. 2 Richardson's Gwendariff Tullys Red Arrows. Another very nice dog from this famous kennel, slightly smaller dog than my 1st, nonetheless he also was very well balanced, gorgeous had and expression correct eye shape and colour, good length of ear correctly placed, lovely neck, shoulders and return of upper arm, good bone neat feet, strong quarters, correct tail set. Another stylish mover. 3 Walker's Gwendariff Flags Are Flyin. OD (3) A pleasing class of dog that I admire greatly, so quite a difficult choice!! 1 Ellrich's Sh Ch, Ir Sh Ch, Fin Sh Ch Gwendariff Absolutely Marwe'luss (IKC) WW25,WW24, CW24. Well this boy certainly deserves all the accolades bestowed upon him, what a showman even down to the little bark he gives now and again while moving as thought to say look at me I am enjoying every minute!! Definitely has all the correct attributes, beautiful head and expression, correct eye shape of unshelled almonds, melting to look at, lovely ear placement and length correct arch to neck, good reach of neck leading into well laid shoulders, return of upper arm and sternum beautiful, deep through body, gently sloping topline strong quarters with correct bend of stifle, short hocks, correct tail set, simply beautiful a fine example of our wonderful breed, all

topped off with fantastic movement. I was overjoyed to award him THE CC, Also in agreement with my co-judge Mr J Barney, the award of BIS SHOW 1!! 2Danks Sh Ch Alolfrana All I Ask Of Eveandabec JW. Admire this boy with his superb shape and melting expression, ample reach of neck fitting into well laid shoulders good bone neat feet slightly longer cast than my winner which on the day made his outline not quite so firm. He has strong quarters correct tail set, straight hocks which enables him to drive and reach out when moving, he was very unlucky to come up against the 1st in this quality class. 3 Beresfords Sh Ch Jetsetter Wind Of Dreams (Imp Rus). Another boy I like but unfortunately had decided to have a huge moult, I am sure he will continue to do well when his full coat returns to its normal beauty.
