VD (5) 1. Sh Ch Lynwood Hocus Pocus at Settesoli JW (Mrs J P Russell) Well this quality male certainly belies his age, at 9 years old he was presented in outstanding coat and condition. Super masculine head with plenty of work and soft expression. Clean muscular neck into excellent forequarters, straight forelegs with good bone, deep chest, ribs carried well back, firm topline into well muscled hindquarters. Balanced angulation fore and aft. His movement is steady and free flowing with plenty of drive from behind. BV Very pleased to watch him win Veteran G3

2. Quensha Walk Me Home to Danwish (Gardner) Another quality male who again was presented in fit muscled condition, and is full of breed type. Balanced in outline, I really liked his head with prominent occiput and especially his soft gentle expression, clean neck of good length into correct shoulder placement, deep chest, well sprung ribs, firm but gentle slope to his topline, he is really well muscled behind with developed 2nd thigh. He was presented in full coat with slight wave, on the move he has an excellent side gait in complete unison with his handler. 3. Staratlanta Get A Wiggle On to Marzanne (Hadfield) MPD (1) 1. Dazycutter Blazing Fire (Turner) At just 8 months I really liked this young man he appealed for construction, balance and breed type. He had an outgoing temperament with correct proportions throughout. I just loved his head with pronounced occiput, low set ears and kind and quizzical expression. Clean neck into super forequarters, body developing nicely for age. Straight forelegs good bone and neat feet. He was so sound on the move keeping his shape at all times. PD (4) 1. Dazycutter Blazing Fire (Turner) Repeat 2. Covarney Mighty Quinn with Stourford (Mr W G & Mrs A C Needs) At 9 months this young man was again of good breed type. Head is showing good proportions with a gentle expression. He has a good length of neck, well held topline, straight forelegs with good bone, balanced angles fore and aft. Presented in good coat, I just preferred the overall shape of winner. 3. Covarney Can't Hear You at Jacingail (Pullen & Atkin) YD (4) 1. Bluesprings Linda's Legacy at Forestfire (Richardson) At 20 month old he is a very smart youngster with a super balanced outline, pleasing head with pronounced occiput, gentle expression and raised brows. Good length of neck into good forequarters, firm topline stood and on the move, well set on tail, well angulated hindquarters. Free active mover from all angles. 2. Ixia Boys Don't Cry at

Shanoah JW (Foster) 19 months old with pleasing outline, and another one of good breed type. He is not quite as mature as winner but he has a very pleasing head of good proportions, dark eye with super expression. Straight forelegs with good bone and feet, he has good leg to body length, firm topline and well-set tail. Overall I preferred the forequarters of winner. 3. Orlanet Slave to Love JW (Hemmings) PGD (11,1) 1. Marzanne Trigger Happy by Thendara JW (Pym) 2 very nice dogs headed this class the winner was a 2 year old beautifully presented dog and won this class for me on his overall construction and breed type. He has a typical outline, masculine head with super expression. Clean neck into good lay of shoulder. firm and gentle sloping topline, short firm loin and strong well angulated hindquarters. On the move he is very positive with correct footfall and with plenty of drive. 2. Quensha Remember The Name Valasarch (Levene & Lewis) 4 year old dog who was close up to winner, he is an honest dog and again he is full of breed type. He has the best of heads with the pronounced occiput, correct amount of chiselling and a melting expression. He is well constructed and has super forequarters, well sprung ribs and short muscled loin. On the move he is extremely sound with a super side gait. LD (6) 1. Gwendariff Bobby Dazzler (IKC) (Dewar) At 21/2 I have done this young man well as a puppy, and he has certainly fulfilled his early potential. He has a clean and typical balanced outline, he is beautifully presented and in superb coat and condition. Really liked his head of correct proportions and pronounced occiput, dark eye, raised brow and such a melting expression. Super length of neck, into excellent forequarters, straight forelegs with good bone and correct feet, deep chested and ribbed well back. Good muscle tone to the hindquarters which he uses to flow around the ring with reach and drive and has an excellent side gait. RCC 2. Bardonhill McIntosh Red at Montgreenan JW (Richardson) This 3 year old is quite a delight to go over, lovely in outline, super balanced head with pronounced occiput, raised brow, dark eye with kind expression. Strong neck in to well laid shoulder, excellent forequarters and superb topline and tailset. He was presented to perfection, he really opens up on the move and has real style and quality. 3. Thendara Haribo at Baibreeze (Abbott) OD (3) 1. Sh Ch Copper's Get Off My Cloud by Bonhomie (Imp Swe) (Edwards) 2 quality males stood 1 and 2 here and it was the performance on the day that split them. This 3 year old was absolutely bang on form, full of quality, he screams Irish Setter and really fills the eye. Totally balanced in outline with a perfect topline and tailset. He has a handsome head of correct proportions, with soft, typical expression. Clean slightly arched neck into well laid shoulders, he has depth of chest and good spring of rib. Muscled loin and hindquarters with developed 2nd thigh. On the move he has excellent reach and drive, is precise in front but it is in profile that he cannot be overlooked. He was presented in excellent gleaming coat; I was pleased to award him the CC. 2. Sh Ch Alolfrana All I Ask of Eveandabec JW (Danks) Another 3 year old quality boy who is very stylish and imposing and super for type. He has the most delightful head and expression, super balanced forequarters, straight forelegs with good bone and firm feet, strong top line, and well set tail. Presented in superb condition, on the move he

covers the ground in profile and is precise fore and aft on an easy action. 3. In/ger/nld Ch Riverwood Very Much Wanted (Mombaerts) SB D/B (8,2) 1.Dendroch Anne Frank (Taylor) 20 month old very feminine young lady, of good make and shape. She has a very pretty head with the most endearing expression. Good length of clean neck into good forequarters with straight forelegs and the correct amount of bone, good depth of chest and body maturing nicely. She has a very outgoing personality and worked well with her handler. On the move she holds her shape and is very sound both fore and aft. 2. Sheldonite More Romance (Spencer) 3 year old male of good make and shape, balanced in outline, very pleasing head with dark eye and soft expression. clean slightly arched neck into well laid back shoulders, strong topline and well angulated quarters Presented in super coat and condition. Moved very well in profile. 3. Gwendariff Grace Kelly (Childs) VB (3, 1) 1.Sh Ch Gwendariff Hot Ticket JW (Bougen) Wow I could not believe this young lady was 9 years young! Just loved her, she is of a lovely size, feminine all through and she just never stopped showing. She has the most delightful feminine head, full of quality, dark eye, raised brow, correct amount of chiselling, with the desired pronounced occiput all combined to give a melting expression. She has good bone, super depth and spring of ribs, and still has muscle tone to her hindquarters. She was presented in perfect condition and in full gleaming coat. Her movement was free and positive, just felt in the challenge the dog had a little more forward reach. 2. Covarney Estee avec Marzanne JW (Hadfield) 8 years old and another quality lady who is racy in outline. She has a lovely head, dark eye and melting expression. slightly arched, neck of good length into well laid-back shoulders, good depth to chest, well sprung ribs and strength to loin. She also was presented in good coat and condition, I just preferred the hind movement of winner. MPB (4, 1)

1. Glitterati Lofty with Quensha (Imp Pol) (Bott, Allen & Morgan) At just 7 months old I really liked her overall shape and balance. She was a little naughty to begin with but I like this in a puppy. Her head is starting to develop, with a nice dark eye and mischievous expression. Good length of neck, into excellent balanced forequarters, her body proportions are developing nicely for her age, firm topline, well set on tail, pleasing hindquarters, with width to the thigh. On the move she is true fore and aft and holds her topline in profile. 2. Dazycutter Crownedbyfire (Bryant) At 8 month she has a typical outline, very feminine and finer all through than winner. Pretty head with soft expression, clean neck, good forequarters with straight forelegs. Correct topline, well ribbed back. Good tailset. Just not as steady on the move as winner. 3. Redclyst Glenury Aoife (Pike) PB (5: 1) 1.Gwendariff Cracklin Rosie for Lochlorien (IKC) (Stevenson) What a little stunner, I loved her cheeky and mischievous outgoing nature. She has a super balanced outline pretty feminine head, dark eye and endearing expression. Her slightly arched elegant neck flows well into excellent forequarters, straight forelegs with good bone and firm feet. Good depth of chest, well sprung ribs carried well back, correct topline, and well angulated hindquarters. Presented in super coat and moved on an easy stride with correct footfall. BPIB 2 Marzanne Lightnin Strikes over Whistlebush

(Menhennett) At 9 months this young lady is not as mature as winner but another one with a super attitude. She has a super balanced outline, the prettiest of heads and a very mischievous expression. Clean slightly arched neck into correct shoulder placement, straight forelegs, chest still needs to drop, level topline, sloping slightly away to the croup. Good hind angulation and once she settled she moved well with good reach and drive. 3. Zimbra Della Magna Sila at Lochfrae (Imp Ita) (Davie) JB (4)

1. Loganrish Winter Pearl Moon JW (Holehan) 2 beautiful exhibits stood here. My winner is a 15 month old who is so balanced and racy in her outline. Really pretty head, long and lean with the desired occiput, dark kind eyes, alert to her handler. Clean neck slightly arched, she has a good flow to her topline, which was firmly held both stood and on the move. Good depth to chest and spring to the ribcage, I liked her hindquarters showing width to the thigh and the correct amount of angulation. On the move she demonstrated lovely reach and drive in her profile movement, Presented in beautiful coat and condition. 2. Sametsuz So to Speak (Sketchley) 13 month old young lady was unlucky to meet 1 today. Another quality young lady who has a typical outline, I Liked her feminine head with all the correct properties. Good length of neck which gives her elegance, straight forelegs with good bone and neat feet, ribs carried well back, correct topline, strong loin and strong hindquarters. A sound free mover. 3. Gwendariff Grace Kelly (Childs) YB (2) 1. Bluesprings Love of My Life for Shirlilah JW (Peters) 19 month old feminine young lady with a balanced outline, and a really outgoing personality. Very pretty head, long and lean with dark eye and cheeky expression., clean slightly arched neck flowing through to a good topline, balanced quarters fore and aft, good body proportions, On the move she is very sound both coming and going at and one with her handler at all times 2. Dendroch Anne Frank (Taylor) PGB (13,3) 1. Gwendariff Rhianna JW (Jones) 2 year old quality young lady and I see she is litter sister to my RDCC. She has a super racy outline. I loved her pretty head, long and lean, well-shaped intelligent eye with the right amount of chiselling. Clean neck into well placed shoulders and a firm topline Straight forelegs with good bone, well sprung rib which was set well back into a correct loin. On the move she is true both ways and displays a super side gait, driving from her strong hindquarters.

2. Emma Coppers Mahogany Dream Catcher (Edwards & Ostman) Another 2 year old quality bitch who is balanced and elegant in outline. She has a beautiful head, so balanced and elegant, dark eye and a lovely kind expression. She has a good reach of neck, which flows well into her strong and level topline, finishing with a correctly set on tail. Body has good depth and spring to the ribs. Strong muscled hindquarters, with good width and correct angulation. Unlucky to meet 1 today I am sure they will change places. On the move she is so sound, correct footfall and with good drive. 3. Marzannes Happy Returns (Hadfield) LB (8, 1) 1. Alolfrana Electra (Danks & Kniveton) At just 2 1/2 years old this young lady presented a racy appearance with lovely flowing body lines. She has the most appealing head, lean and long with pronounced occiput. Good length of slightly arched neck, which flowed into her firmly held topline and well set on tail,

good depth of brisket, straight forelegs with good bone and feet. She has a good spring to the ribs, carried well back, strong hindquarters, showing a good width and bend of stifle in good muscle tone. Moving with a ground covering action, and presented in good coat and condition 2. Covarney Dream Time from Bronrians JW (Clarke) Shapely 5 year old mature lady, feminine and elegant in her profile. Pretty head, long and lean, and well proportioned with a lovely dark eye. Long slightly arched neck, into good forequarters, good depth to the brisket and spring of ribs. Firm slightly sloping topline and strong in her hindquarters. A free mover, just not as positive as winner. Presented in a beautiful coat. 3. Ferasheen Pop The Changers JW (Sloane) OB (3) 1. Sh Ch Gwendariff Skys The Limit (IKC) (Roffey) I have always admired this young lady and she certainly did not disappoint today. She just did not put a foot wrong, to me she screams Irish Setter, she is so full of quality, elegance and raciness, she has a natural presence about her that cannot be ignored. She oozes confidence and character and that certainly shone through. I loved her head, long and lean, oval skull, with the desired occiput, dark eye, raised brows, and the most endearing yet inquisitive expression. Elegant clean neck smoothly flowing into a strong topline which was held at all times. Chest deep, ribs well sprung and carried well back, firm over the loin. Nicely angulated muscled hindquarters. She cannot be ignored on the move, she has excellent reach and drive, good head and tail carriage, keeping a strong and firm topline, perfect footfall and totally at one with her handler. I was pleased to award her the CC and BOB 2. Ch Caemgen's Keep An Eye On Me (Jobse) Another quality young lady who catches the eye who is sound in her construction and has a typical outline. Just right for size and balance, with nothing overdone, each part flowing into the next. She is feminine but has strength and substance and gives the impression of being able to work all day. She has a pleasing head, with a thoughtful and kind expression. Strong neck with a slight arch, good depth and spring to the ribcage. Holds a firm topline both stood and on the move, with a well carried tail. Her strong hindquarters used well on the move to show a true driving action. Presented to perfection and unlucky to meet I today I was pleased to award her the RCC 3. Sh Ch Glennara Cherry Cola JW (Hall)
